 - Presented a report of energy efficiency on the occasion of the 2010 G8 summit at Muskoka
 - Established infrastructure to enable easy global communication between energy regulators
 - Established a work plan with clear deliverables on the regulatory aspects of the global challenges we face
 - Launched new ICER Distinguished Scholar Awards
 - Established links with international organisations with common interests
