Eastern European Energy Leaders in Brussels to Upgrade Skills in Green Transition



The Council of European Energy Regulators (CEER), on behalf of the European Union's EU4Energy Phase II Programme – Promoting the Clean Energy Transition in the Eastern Partnership Countries is welcoming high-level energy professionals for a capacity-strengthening course that focuses on the clean energy transition.

Over the two-day training, energy regulators and policymakers from relevant ministries will learn and exchange views about new challenges related to the implementation of the Clean Energy for All Europeans Package. They will also explore ways to accelerate cooperation within the region including by promoting the approximation of national legislations of EaP countries with European Union (EU) requirements. The goal is to help reach a common understanding among country representatives on EU policy, regulatory framework and available assistance.

The training sessions will allow for a detailed analysis of factors that influence public and regulatory policy debate. Participants will also discuss the ways to adapt regulatory frameworks to changes in the sector while maintaining investment certainty. The roles of the major actors involved in European energy policy development, decision-making processes at EU level, and the challenges for regulatory authorities in ensuring the effective implementation of the new regulatory framework will also be addressed.

The training, managed by the Council of European Energy Regulators (CEER), is organised in the framework of the EU4Energy Programme Phase II – Promoting the Clean Energy Transition in the Eastern Partnership Countries, which runs until December 2024. The programme aims to contribute to the development of sound legislative and regulatory frameworks for energy, to support the region's transition to clean energy and the liberalisation of its energy markets.

The EU4Energy initiative is funded by the European Union with a total budget of €8.5 million and is jointly implemented by CEER, the International Energy Agency (IEA) and the Energy Community Secretariat (EnCS).
