- > The joint Task Force was established in September 2018 to align GIE and ENTSOG on CS topics and regulatory developments.
- > 46 ENTSOG/GIE members
- > Main attention point: follow-up EC initiative on a Network Code on Cyber Security
 - Analysis of the 2nd interim report of the Smart Grid Task Force 2 on cyber security in the smart grid environment
 - Follow up on the recommendations from EC on Cyber Security in the energy sector
 - Applicability to the gas sector
- > Follow up on cyber security activities:
 - Co-host of the Joint ENTSOE / GIE / ENTSOG Cyber Security Workshop 15/03/19, Brussels
 - Participation at the Energy Community Cyber Security day 11/04/19, Vienna

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Upcoming tasks

- > Survey regarding the implementation status of the NIS regulation among the ENTSOG/GIE members
- > Information sharing about Cyber Security incidents / threats
- > Planned cooperation with a renowned consultant
- > Planned cooperation with national cyber security authorities
- Digitalisation: possible consideration this topic in the aspect of "operational security" (e.g. SCADA, metering) digitalisation and forming an expert TF.
- > Analysis of the final report of the Smart Grid Task Force 2 on cyber security in the smart grid environment
