1st WORKSHOP ON REGULATORY CONVERGENCE THE ENERGY REGULATORS ROLE, POWERS AND CHALLENGES

Workshop objectives: The aim of this workshop is to launch an exchange of regulatory experiences and practices across European borders between the regulators of the Eastern Partnership (EaP).

Organisation: At the beginning of each session, representatives from the regulatory authorities of the six partner countries, from the Council of European Energy Regulators (CEER) and associated regulatory cooperation structures will be asked to give brief presentations (5-10 minutes each) on their reciprocal experience and current challenges related to the topic of the session. Presentations will be followed by a moderated discussion with workshop participants, based on a set of questions which will be circulated to confirmed participants ahead of the workshop.

Expected outcome: After an initial discussion on the regulatory frameworks and energy policies of partner countries, EaP regulators will have the possibility to evaluate the joint discussions and to consider further work of mutual interest, possibly establishing a common plan for deepened dialogue and cooperation. The discussions should reveal which topics could be discussed in more detail in the future and identify concrete issues where European Energy Regulators could efficiently assist EaP countries. Further topics of common interest for a second workshop may notably include regulatory tools in support of infrastructure development, interconnection and diversification of supply.

Target audience: Representatives of the Eastern Partnership’s regulatory community, i.e. regulatory authorities of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine and the 27 Member States as well as representatives of their regional associations (CEER and the Energy Regulators Regional Association (ERRA)); Representatives from the Energy Community Regulatory Board (ECRB) and the INOGATE team are invited to attend as well.
