Proposals to merge entry/exit zones have to address a number of concerns

- 1. Is it necessary? Competition can take place across zonal boundaries
- 2. Will it help? One can merge zones without creating a single market
- 3. Will merging zones create distortions? If there is congestion at zonal boundary then incentives to arbitrage between day-ahead and balancing market (cf British experience in electricity)
- 4. Increased need for an Inter-TSO Compensation mechanism
- If long-term transmission capacity financed via Open Season, short-term is free then risk of distortions
- 6. Practical difficulty of harmonising market rules across Member States (cf Irish experience with SEM)
