

Progress in 2011

November December 2011 2012 January

First REMIT Workshop in Ljubljana



ACER publishes the first edition of the Guidance on the definitions set out in article 2 of REMIT (pursuant to article 16(1))



Web-based forms made available for notifications of delayed publications of inside information and suspected breaches

28 Dec

8 Dec 2011 REMIT published on the OJ 28 Dec 2011
REMIT enters
into force

Implementation Priorities for H1 2012

- Notifications and transparency
- Registration Format

Registration Format: Timeline

| Activity | Timing |
|---|----------------------|
| Public consultation | Mid-April to mid-May |
| Public workshop in Ljubljana | April |
| DETERMINATION AND PUBLICATION OF THE FORMAT | By 29 June |

Note: the Implementing Acts may impact on some aspects of the registration format, e.g. if the record of transactions also requires to identify the trader or depending on the approach to the "ultimate controller or beneficiary of trading activities"



Record of Transactions: Timeline

| Activity | Timing |
|--|----------------------------|
| Public consultation | Early June to mid-July |
| Public workshop in Ljubljana | June |
| RECOMMENDATION ADOPTED AND SENT TO THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION | By the end of September |



ACER Guidance to NRAs

- Legal basis: Art. 16(1) of REMIT
- Describes ACER's understanding of the definitions of Art. 2 of REMIT, but does not provide legal interpretation
- Directed to NRAs and intended only to establish a common understanding between ACER and NRAs on REMIT definitions (Art. 2)
- Published for sake of transparency



Second Edition of ACER Guidance

- Review interpretation of market abuse definitions in the 1st edition of the ACER Guidance on the basis of experience
- Increase the scope of ACER Guidance to definitions of "market participant" and "wholesale energy product"
