*Subject: request for amendment on the proposal by all Transmission System Operators to further specify and harmonise imbalance settlement in accordance with Article 52(2) of the Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing*

Dear Mr Schmitt,

I am writing to you on behalf of all regulatory authorities with regard to the proposal by all Transmission System Operators (TSOs) to further specify and harmonise imbalance settlement (ISH proposal) in accordance with Article 52(2) of the Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing (EBGL).

The last Regulatory Authority received the proposal on 11 February 2019. Article 5(6) of the EBGL requires relevant Regulatory Authorities to consult and closely cooperate and coordinate with each other in order to reach an agreement, and make decisions within six months following receipt of submissions of the last relevant Regulatory Authority concerned, i.e. by 11 August 2019.

The enclosed document, dated 14 June 2019, elaborates an agreement of all regulatory authorities to request an amendment to the ISH proposal submitted by all TSOs and is intended to constitute the basis on which all regulatory authorities will each subsequently request an amendment to the proposal pursuant to Article 6(1) of the EBGL.

This agreement of All Regulatory Authorities shall provide evidence that a decision on the ISH proposal does not need to be adopted by ACER, at this stage, pursuant to Article 5(7) of the EBGL.

All Regulatory Authorities have agreed to issue their national decision to request an amendment to the ISH proposal on the basis of this agreement by 11 August 2019.
