The capability of wholesale energy markets as they are currently designed to provide economic signals capable of ensuring appropriate perspectives of cost recovery to new assets and, hence, of triggering investment decisions, is not guaranteed. The developments encompass the likely reinforcement of electricity grids due to electrification, the short and long term usage of natural gas grids and the position of gas during the energy transition, the potential of hydrogen, the interaction with heat and the creation of Local Energy Communities. The developments in those grids require NRAs to rethink what a fair distribution of costs would be, for example on how costs of stranded assets would be included in tariffs when customer numbers/usage is declining in light of decarbonisation. This could include further thinking on the whole system approach.
