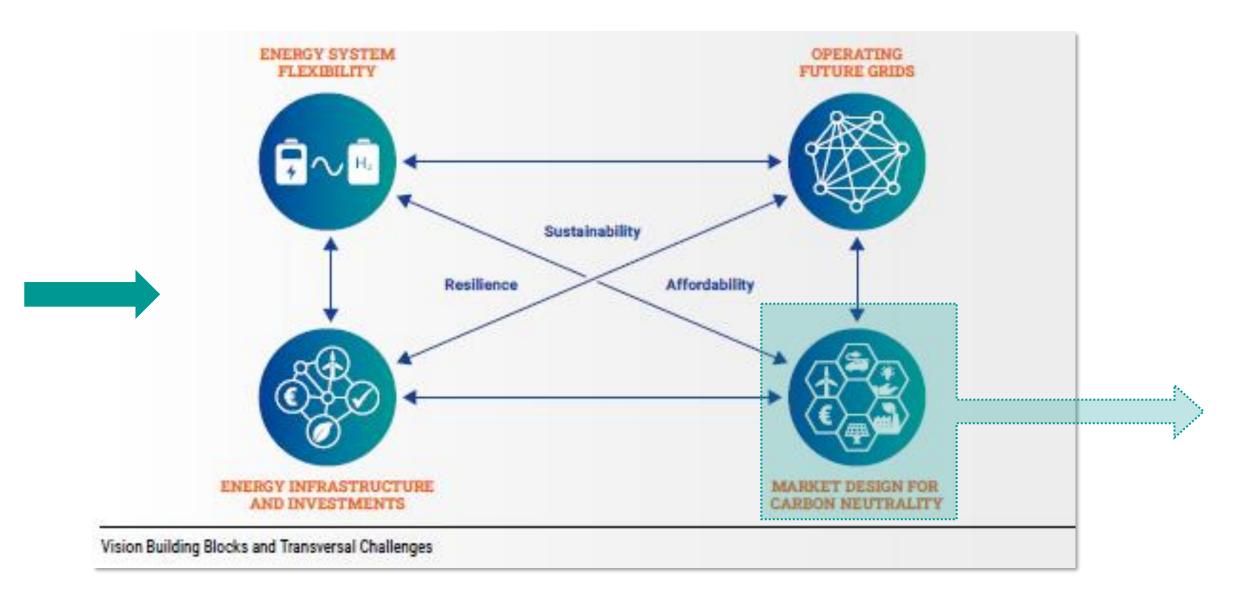

EMDR SCOPE



Accelerate lowcarbon Investments Well-designed 2-way CfDs for new assets

- + facilitating uptake of **PPAs** and hedging in **forward markets**
- + stable and forward-looking regulatory framework





Boost Flexibility & Demand Response

Preserving **short-term price signals**

- + removing entry barriers for **flex providers**
- + competition behind the meter (shield vulnerable customers)





Ensure system adequacy Capacity Mechanisms 2.0 for dispatchable resources

- + taking into account grid constraints
- + ancillary services availability





Reduce system constraints & costs

Stronger locational signals in: (1) wholesale & balancing markets, (2) Capacity Mechanisms, (3) RES support schemes, (4) grid tariffs



EMDR comparative analysis details and further needs

At the target in the initial EC proposal



2 way CfD & PPA strengthen investment signals for low-carbon & RES assets

Marginal short-term pricing & market function preserved, no price caps

New framework for EU/regional price crisis for higher regulatory certainty and political interventions' boundaries

TSOs' regulatory framework with recognition of anticipatory investments & OPEX

Consumer protection and empowerment including possible use of sub-metering to enhance consumers' flexibility

Enhancements

by Parliament and Council



Improved CfDs design principles for reaction

to market prices & system needs

Capacity Mechanisms: EC to review framework to simplify introduction

Reform of forward markets: Regional Virtual Hubs possible only subject to adequate impact assessment & consultation

Longer deadlines & possible derogations for shorter of cross-zonal **ID Gate Closure Time**

Still to be addressed

ENTSO-E view



Flexibility Needs Assessment: consistency with system studies building on existing methodologies, governance, expertise

Congestion income use for offshore generation connected to hybrid interconnectors: clearly defined scope & relation to capacity calculation requirements (i.e. 70%)

Peak-shaving product activation rules

Reasonable publication requirements for new available connections' capacity



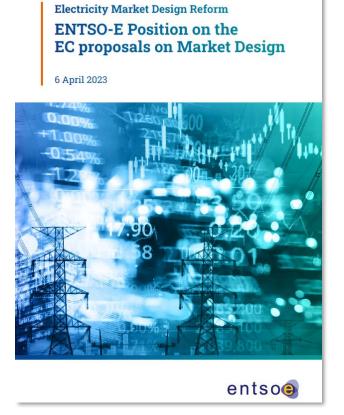

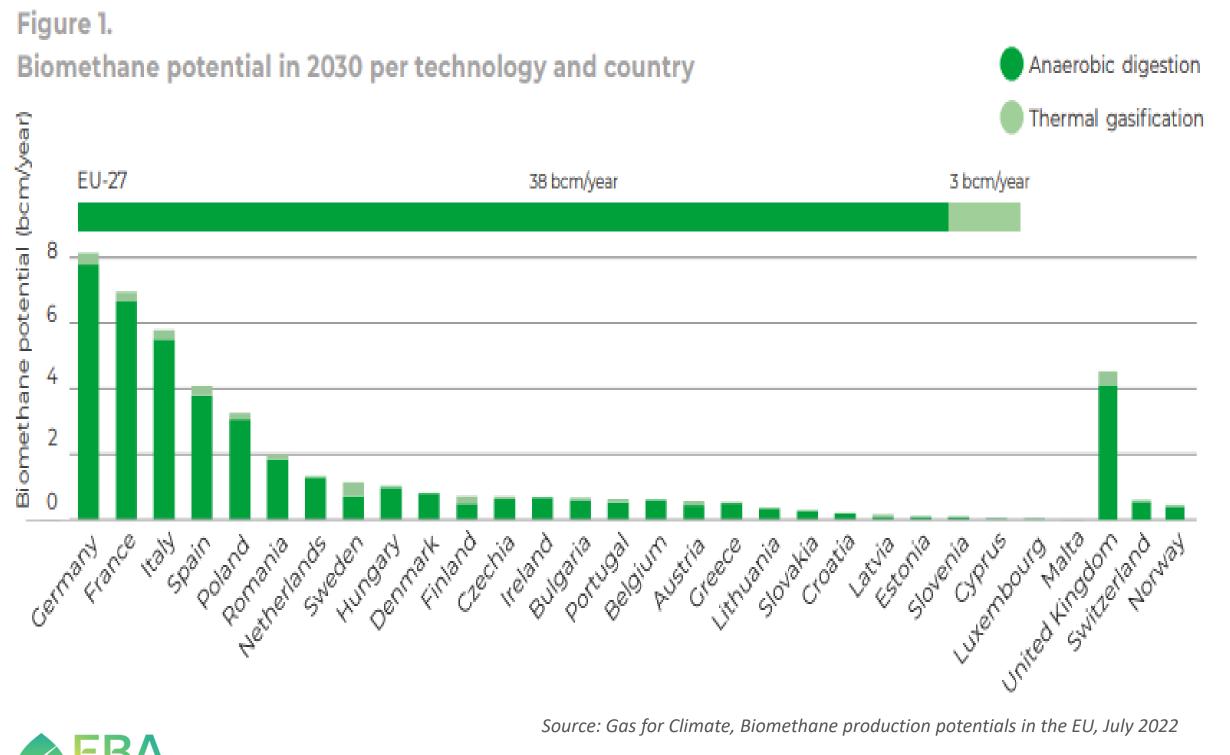

2030 national sustainable biomethane potentials





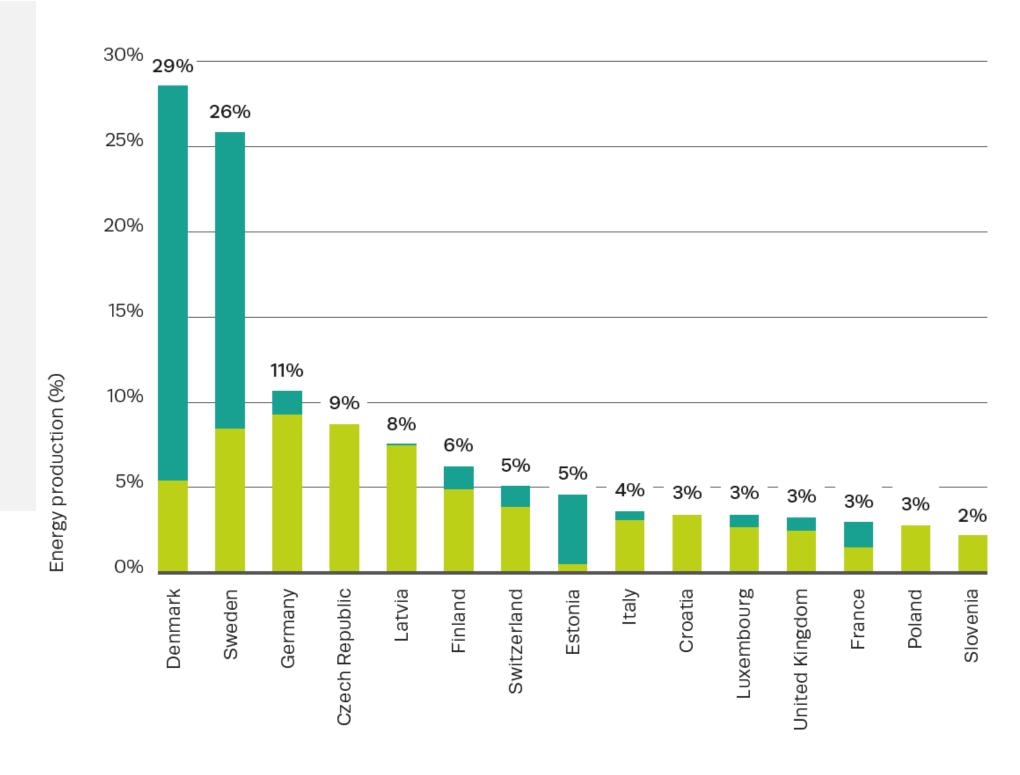
- EU27's production
 potential can meet the
 35 bcm REPowerEU
 target
- 15% of natural gas demand in 2030
- 40-60% of imported natural gas by 2050



Biomethane and biogas relative to natural gas consumption

- Biomethane and biogas production relative to each country's natural gas consumption in 2022.
- Denmark and Sweden are well on track to replace natural gas with biomethane
- In September 2023, Denmark already reaches
 40% of biomethane in their gas grid

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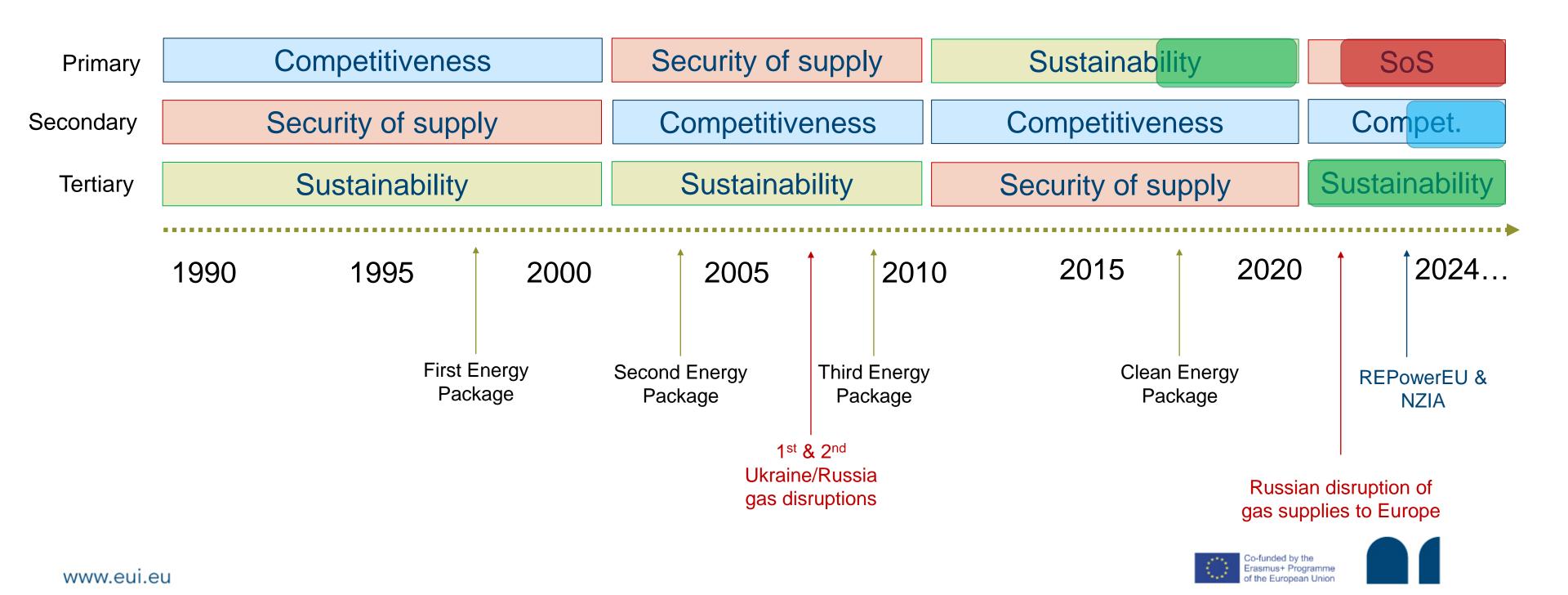

The evolving role of clean hydrogen in European energy policy objectives...







EU Hydrogen Strategy: 4mt

Fit for 55: 10mt

REPowerEU: 20mt

NZIA & GDIP: 20mt + manufacturing, CRM, etc.

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Key Messages: Decarbonisation of Gas

- -Hydrogen can help to decarbonise "hard to abate" economic sectors => Households are NOT "hard to abate"
- Hydrogen faces many challenges: sourcing, transport, finance, regulatory, transparency, costs and efficiency
- -Avoid replicating regulatory "traps" known from fossil gas



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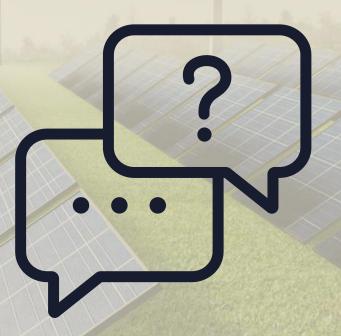
