Timeline for REMIT implementation


REMIT's entry into force

- 28 Dec Prohibitions of insider dealing and market manipulation apply for market
 - participants
 - Obligation to publish inside information applies for market participants

• Deployment of the ICT System for Trading and Fundamental Data Collection and Market Monitoring Expected "go-live": Q1 2014



New TEN-E Guidelines Implementation (based on the latest Council text from 27 June)

- Assessment of the consistent application of the criteria/Cost-Benefit Analysis (CBA) methodology for individual PCI and evaluation of their European added value within each Region, where necessary
- Opinion on the consistency application of the criteria and the CBA across regions
- Opinion on the CBA methodology proposed by ENTSOs
- Guidance on incentives and common methodology to evaluate the incurred higher risks of investments in electricity and gas transmission
- Monitor PCI implementation, provide recommendations, consolidated report to Groups
