

We need to speak the same language.


# Association of Issuing Bodies AIB

- About half of AIB's members are also competent bodies for disclosure
- 30% of annual RES production in EU, EEA (and CH)
- And almost all certified RES production

- Our aim: In a transparent market, consumers vote with...









#### Markets ARE International







#### Cancelled per year of transaction (TWh)




#### Markets ARE International








#### Imported per year (TWh)





Consumer – large and small – use GOs for emission statements



An accepted relation between electricity and carbon emission is needed

Applied for RES, fossil, nuclear, CHP... all electricity.

# The energy market of the future...



- Gives full disclosure on the origin of energy to consumers, not just on RES;
- Translates the carbon impact consistantly;
- Matches the social value with an EU-wide economical price;
- Lets consumers "vote with their feet", steering initiatives in the public interest.
- Helps to find an integral approach to a strong RES energy market.
