

Next steps – Theme 1

- Consistency with legal framework important
- **Theme 1**: ERGEG to continue preparation of input to framework guideline on capacity allocation and CM
 - Channels the PCG work into the 3rd package framework
 - Will apply IA process (involvement of stakeholders, public consultation)
 - Ad Hoc advisory group of stakeholders to be established by ERGEG

- **Theme 2:** Work through ERI Regions
 - ERIs seen as having a role in implementing the approved framework guidelines early on
 - ERI (with coordination in RIG) to undertake certain regional projects
 - A way to accelerate progress
- **Theme 3:** Individual projects
 - In all the PCG workstream areas more elaboration and design work needed
 - PCG project propositions would be input to development projects
 - Work Programme resource implications



Ad Hoc Advisory Group of Stakeholders

- To advise ERGEG in the development of input to the FG on capacity allocation and congestion management
- To monitor and coordinate projects that are established to carry forward the work of PCG
- The dual role (FG development and coordination of projects) will ensure a good flow of information between the projects and the FG work
- To comprise representatives of the relevant stakeholder organisations of the electricity sector (ENTSO-E, EuroPEX, EFET, Eurelectric, large consumers) and the Commission, chaired by ERGEG
