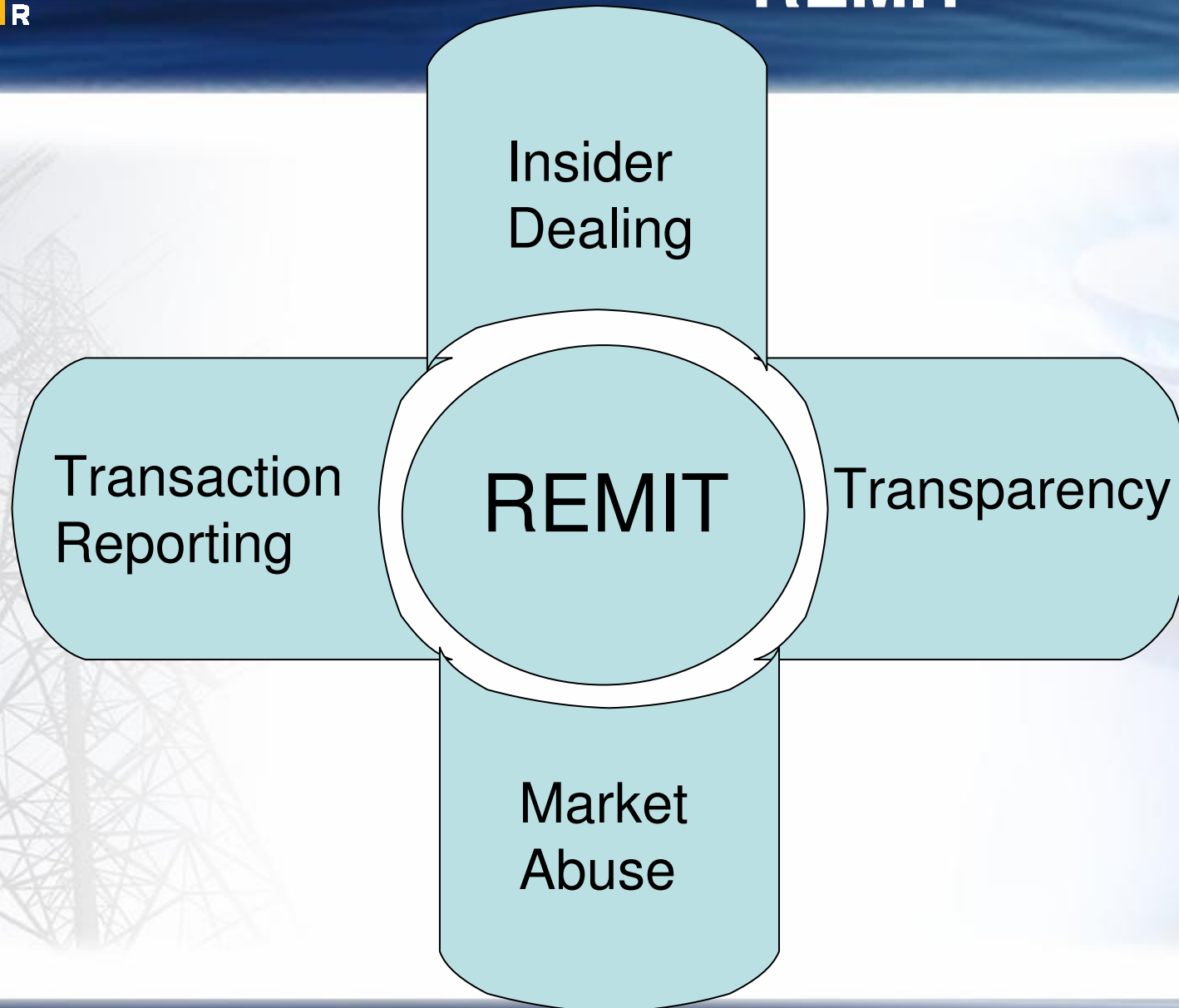

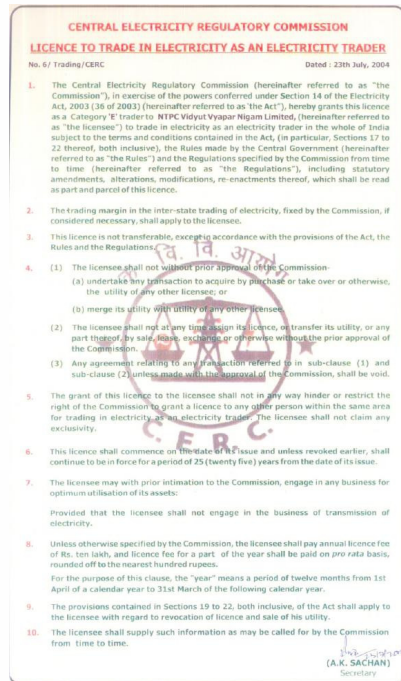

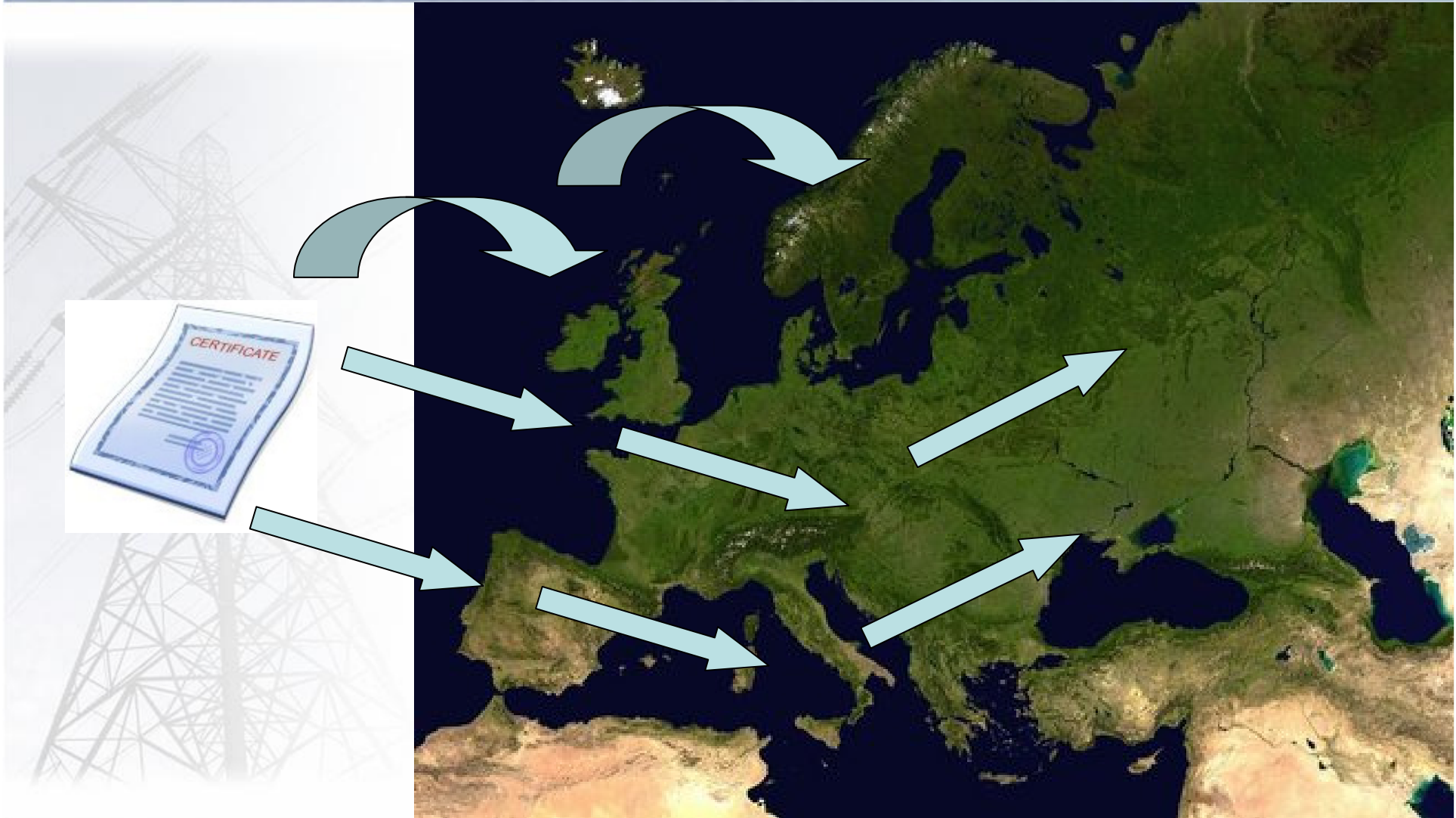

Key aspects of CEER advice

One single trading license:

- permits European-wide trading activities
- covers electricity and gas
- necessary for wholesale trading (not supply)
- considered by the home country of the trading companies headquarters
- fees are cost-based
