

2.1 CEER Positions on the review of RED II by Annegret Groebel – CEER President

Renewable energy will be very important in delivering the EU's higher climate ambition for 2030 and carbon neutrality by 2050



Review of RED II needs to be more ambitious – EU target of at least 32% renewable energy for 2030



Improve **consumer awareness** about the sources of electricity consumed in a given year/month



Additional efforts needed for increased RES in: electricity, gas, heating and cooling, district heating and cooling, transport

More specific changes to the Directive

Rules for renewable gas (incl. hydrogen) support schemes

Remove barriers for use of PPAs

Access on info share of renewable fuels for consumers

Enable market rules for & promote hydrogen/renewable synthetic fuels/ gases
