WHAT IS THIS COURSE ABOUT?

NRA staff need expertise to carry out monitoring and surveillance activities of the wholesale energy markets at national level according to REMIT.

As part of this, NRA staff need to understand REMIT's provisions as well as market abuse behaviours, investigation and enforcement procedures, interactions with financial market regulation and anti-trust regulation.

This will help to facilitate effective cooperation in particular in cross-border cases to ensure compatibility and consistency in the application of measures dealing with potential market abuse and their enforcement in energy markets.

The focus will be put on the way the energy transition impacts on the wholesale energy markets and what this means for NRAs when implementing REMIT (and in the future REMIT-II).
